Welcome to the autumn edition of our newsletter.

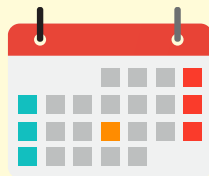
You may be aware from previous newsletters of the plan to build a new town of up to 6,000 houses centred around Throckmorton, together with associated infrastructure and industry. As you know we are strongly against this as it will dramatically change our area, and a formal objection been submitted. The three councils involved in the plan, namely Wychavon DC, Malvern Hills DC and Worcester City Council, have now submitted their plan to the Planning Inspector. The next stage is that the proposals will be assessed and a public hearing will take place, possibly next autumn, prior to a final decision being made. We will continue to keep you updated on this.

Some of you may also be aware that there are a number of planning applications within our Parish which are still waiting to be determined by the Planning Officers at Wychavon DC. The oldest of these are now over 12 months old. Delays have been caused by staff shortages within the Planning Department, however we are pressing for these to be dealt with.

Finally, you will have received a letter from Severn Trent detailing upgrade work which will be taking place at Lower Moor sewage station. It is inevitable that this will result in some disruption, particularly with increased vehicle movements, however once completed we are told that the existing system will have been completely replaced. This will mean an increased capacity and hopefully an end to the daily tankering of waste off site. There should also be a reduction in odour and an improvement in the water quality of discharges into the River Avon. This upgrade has been long awaited.

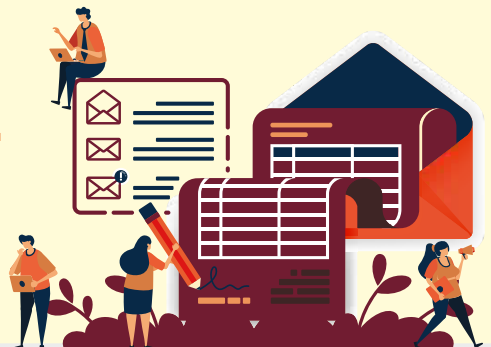
