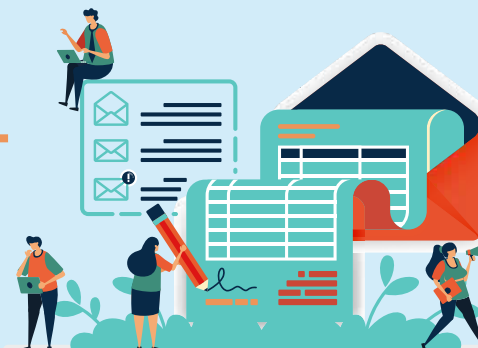

LOWER MOOR ALLOTMENTS ASSOCIATION REPORT

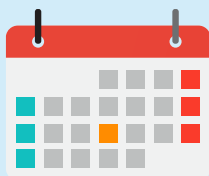
Currently there are 4 allotment plots available. Two available to use straight away and the other 2 needing some considerable work to get into a state to use.
